For Ages 14-21 In The Visual Arts

ArtWorks is hiring approximately 100 emerging artists ages 14-21 for summer jobs as Apprentice Artists.

- The majority of available jobs are for PAINTERS. A small number of jobs may be available in photography, graphic design, sewing/textiles and landscape arts. Specific job descriptions will be available on ArtWorks' Website, ArtWorksCincinnati.org, by April 16, 2012.
- Projects range from four nine weeks between June 11 and August 10, 2012.
- The work schedule is generally Monday Friday, 9 a.m. 2 p.m.
- Apprentice Artists earn minimum wage, \$7.70/hour.
