The Oak Hills High School Gallery of Honor seeks to recognize and celebrate the outstanding achievements of its alumni in the field of art and design. Nominations for induction into the Hall of Honor should meet the following criteria to demonstrate excellence in the realm of art and design:

- 1. **Distinguished Creative Accomplishments**: Nominees must have demonstrated exceptional creativity, innovation, and skill in their chosen field of art and design. Their body of work should exemplify a high level of artistic excellence and aesthetic prowess.
- 2. **Significant Impact**: Nominees should have made a noteworthy impact on their respective art and design disciplines, contributing to the advancement, evolution, or transformation of the field. Their work should have influenced, inspired, or left a lasting impression on the industry or the broader community.
- 3. **Professional Standing**: Nominees should have established a strong professional reputation within the art and design community.
- **4. Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Originality:** Nominees should be known for pushing the boundaries of artistic expression and design concepts. Their work should showcase a commitment to originality, pushing their field forward through fresh perspectives, techniques, or approaches.
- 5. **Sustained Career Success**: Nominees should have maintained a consistent and notable career trajectory within the art and design industry over a substantial period of time. Their contributions should demonstrate ongoing dedication and commitment to their craft.
- 6. **Community Engagement**: Nominees should have actively engaged with their local and global communities, using their artistic talents to enrich lives, foster cultural understanding, or contribute to social change. Their involvement should extend beyond their personal accomplishments to positively impact others.
- 7. **Multidisciplinary Excellence**: While a nominee's primary focus may be in a specific art or design discipline, consideration may also be given to those who have successfully embraced cross-disciplinary collaborations, bridging different creative domains to achieve exceptional outcomes.
- 8. **Exemplification of Oak Hills High School Values**: Nominees should embody the values of Oak Hills High School, demonstrating qualities such as integrity, perseverance, leadership, and a commitment to personal growth and lifelong learning.



Oak Hills High School Art and Design Gallery of Honor Nomination Process

To nominate a deserving individual for induction into the Oak Hills High School Gallery of Honor for, please adhere to the following submission protocol:

- 1. **Eligibility Verification**: Confirm that the nominee is an Oak Hills High School graduate who has made significant contributions to the field of art and design.
- 2. <u>Nomination Form Completion</u>: Complete the official Gallery of Honor <u>nomination form</u>, which can be obtained from the Oak Hills High School Art and Design website and social media accounts. Ensure that all required fields are accurately filled out.
 - **Nominator Information**: Include your own contact information and a brief statement explaining your reasons for nominating the individual.
 - Nominee Information: Provide detailed information about the nominee, including their full name, contact information, graduation year from Oak Hills High School, and a brief biography highlighting their achievements and contributions to art and design.
- 3. Nominees will be required to submit the following:

Criteria Documentation: Compile a comprehensive package of materials that demonstrate how the nominee meets the established criteria for induction. Including

- 1. A Curriculum Vitae that includes:
 - ✓ Documentation of awards, recognitions, and honors received.
 - Examples of the nominee's impact on the art and design community, such as exhibition records, publications, or collaborations.
 - ✓ Information about the nominee's involvement in community engagement, education, mentorship, and other relevant activities.
 - Any additional supporting materials that highlight the nominee's achievements and contributions.

Letters of Support: Collect a minimum of 1 letter of support from individuals who can attest to the nominee's character, contributions, and impact in the field of art and design. These letters could come from colleagues, mentors, peers, students, or individuals who have been positively influenced by the nominee's work.

Portfolio: of 5 images showcasing the nominee's most significant and representative works or candid shots of their working environment.

2. **Submission Deadline**: Ensure that all nomination materials, including the completed nomination form, supporting documentation, and letters of support, are submitted by the specified deadline. Late submissions may not be considered.

Review and Selection Process: Nominations will be reviewed by a selection committee composed of Oak Hills High School Art and Design Department. The committee will evaluate each nomination based on the established criteria.

Notification: Nominators and nominees will be notified of the committee's decision via email or mail. Inductees will receive detailed information about the induction ceremony and any additional steps required for their participation.

Induction Ceremony: Inductees will be honored at a formal induction ceremony hosted by Oak Hills High School at the annual Oak Hills Local School District Art Exhibition and Awards Ceremonies in March. The event will provide an opportunity to celebrate the accomplishments of the honorees and to inspire current students pursuing careers in art and design.
